Baptism at Our Lady Queen of Peace

To have your child Baptized at Our Lady Queen of Peace Church, you must call the office at least 3 months in advance to arrange an appointment with the Pastor. It is assumed that the family has Our Lady Queen of Peace parish connection and practices the faith by attending Sunday Mass on a weekly basis. You may meet with the Pastor and take the course even if your child has not yet been born. Parents are expected to participate in the Baptismal preparation. At least one Godparent or both must be baptized and confirmed and are practicing Catholics. Non-parishioners are required to have a Letter of Recommendation from your Pastor to have your child Baptized in our parish.

Sow Much Love - Development & Peace

I am so pleased with the response for this year's campaign to sign the petition to the government of Canada to adopt international policies that support the small family farmers and to consult with them to support their rights to freely exchange seeds. We obtained 85 signatures on the petition and I will be presenting that to Randall Garrison's office next week (NDP Randall Garrison is MP for Esquimalt – Juan de Fuca in the House of Commons). Thank you all for your support.

A Voice For Justice

You may have seen the poster that indicated our request on postcards (85,000 from Catholic churches) last year was not supported after all. These were requesting the government to have an Ombudsperson for those with complaints against Canadian Mining Companies. However, a few interesting changes came about that were part of the demands of the A Voice for Justice campaign: For example, Development and Peace is pleased to note the inclusion of the UN's Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights among the guidelines on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR). Companies will be encouraged to participate in the process of dialogue with communities ("dispute resolution mechanism") and that the commercial support of the Government of Canada in international markets will be withdrawn from companies that refuse to take part in this process.

Volunteers Needed for Tax Return Assistance

Would you be able to help people complete their income tax forms? The **Society of Saint Vincent de Paul** with income tax preparation and we need volunteers for this valuable service within the CRD. A completed income tax form opens the door for those in need to receive essential benefits such as the Child Tax Credit. Volunteers make a 3 month commitment from February to April and receive a tax preparation on-line class from Revenue Canada.
