Sacramental Information

Baptism: at Our Lady Queen of Peace you must call the office at least 3 months in advance to arrange an appointment with the Pastor. It is assumed that the family has Our Lady Queen of Peace parish connection and practices the faith by attending Sunday Mass on a weekly basis. You may meet with the Pastor and take the course even if your child has not yet been born. Parents are expected to participate in the Baptismal preparation. At least one Godparent or both must be baptized and confirmed and are practicing Catholics. Non-parishioners are required to have a Letter of Recommendation from your Pastor to have your child Baptized in our parish.

Marriage: at Our Lady Queen of Peace because the Church is deeply concerned about each marriage, couples are asked to give a minimum of six months' notice prior to the intended date of their wedding. Church policy requires that marriages be performed in your home parish – unless you are registered and attend elsewhere.

<u>Funeral:</u> at Our Lady Queen of Peace individual arrangements with a priest. Begin by calling the parish office.

ITINERARY RELEASED FOR POPE'S VISIT TO CANADA

This past June 23rd, the Vatican announced the itinerary for Pope's Visit to Canada:

- July 24 The Holy Father will arrive in Edmonton, Alberta.
- July 25 Pope Francis will visit Maskwacis, home to the former Ermineskin Residential School. Later in that day, the Pontiff will visit Sacred Heart Church of the First Peoples
- July 26 On St. Anne's feast day, in an open to public event, The Holy Father will celebrate an open-air Mass at Commonwealth Stadium in Edmonton. Early in that evening, the Holy Father will travel to Lac Ste. Anne.
- July 27 The Holy Father will depart Edmonton for Quebec City and the Pontiff will visit La Citadelle, where he will take part in private meetings.
- July 28 Pope Francis will travel to Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupre, where he will celebrate Mass at one of the oldest and most popular pilgrimage sites in North America. Later in the day, His Holiness will meet with bishops, priests, seminarians, consecrated men and women as well as those who work in various church ministries.
- July 29 Following a private meeting with the Society of Jesus order, Pope Francis will meet with Indigenous leaders from Eastern Canada before departing for Igaluit, where he will spend the afternoon in a private meeting with residential school survivors before attending a public community event hosted by Intuit.

The Holy Father will depart for Rome from Igaluit in the early evening.
