## **Sacramental Information**

**Baptism:** at Our Lady Queen of Peace you must call the office at least 3 months in advance to arrange an appointment with the Pastor. It is assumed that the family has Our Lady Queen of Peace parish connection and practices the faith by attending Sunday Mass on a weekly basis. You may meet with the Pastor and take the course even if your child has not yet been born. Parents are expected to participate in the Baptismal preparation. At least one Godparent or both must be baptized and confirmed and are practicing Catholics. Non-parishioners are required to have a Letter of Recommendation from your Pastor to have your child Baptized in our parish.

**Marriage:** at Our Lady Queen of Peace because the Church is deeply concerned about each marriage, couples are asked to give a minimum of six months' notice prior to the intended date of their wedding. Church policy requires that marriages be performed in your home parish – unless you are registered and attend elsewhere.

**<u>Funeral</u>: at Our Lady Queen of Peace** individual arrangements with a priest. Begin by calling the parish office.

## **Precious Blood**

The month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood. The feast of the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted in 1849 by Pius IX, but the devotion is as old as Christianity. The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, and that the sacraments were brought forth through His Blood.

"The Precious Blood which we worship is the Blood which the Savior shed for us on Calvary and reassumed at His glorious Resurrection; it is the Blood which courses through the veins of His risen, glorified, living body at the right hand of God the Father in heaven; it is the Blood made present on our altars by the words of Consecration; it is the Blood which merited sanctifying grace for us and through it washes and beautifies our soul and inaugurates the beginning of eternal life.

#### **RCIA**

For the past few months, pastors from the Victoria region (including Western communities) along with various RCIA team members have been discussing the possibility of having a city-wide RCIA program instead of having each parish duplicate efforts. RCIA is the name given to the process whereby interested participants learn about God and the Church with a view to joining the Catholic community.

We're happy to say that agreement has been reached whereby this will be a reality beginning in September. This will mean that participants will still apply to their own parish for entry into the program and all ritual celebrations will take place within the individual parishes. Ritual celebrations include such moments as the Rite of Becoming a Catechumen, Scrutinies, Rite of Lenten Renewal and, of course, Baptism or Reception into the Church.

Teaching sessions will be held at St. Joseph's parish as the parish has space for such and is central especially to those from the Western communities. Teaching sessions will be shared by the various parishes' teaching teams according to a pre-determined schedule.
